Tuition is free for club members, and costs \$150 for non-members. (Tuition fee is applicable toward club membership.) You will also need

to purchase a set of materials that cost about \$160. The FAA charges \$80 to administer the written examination.

### When are classes?

All class sessions will be held at the Texins Activity Center on the TI North Campus (13900 North Central Expressway; northeast corner of LBJ and Central) on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:30 PM until 9:30 PM.

### When can I actually begin flying?
